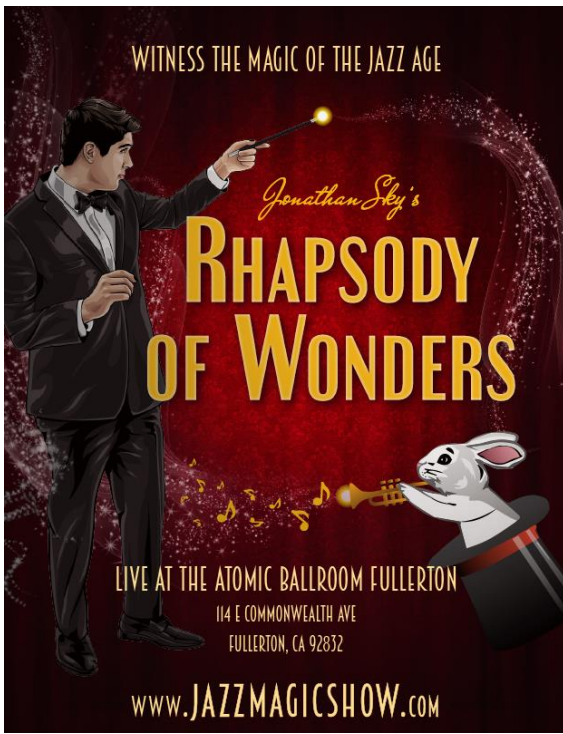


RHAPSODY OF WONDERS

FAQ's

Do I need to print out my ticket or have them on my phone?

All we need is the *name* that you provided when the tickets were ordered however, we recommend having access to your receipt in case of any confusion or dispute.

Is seating assigned?

General seating is unassigned and is on a first come, first serve basis. Front row reservations are available at an extra charge and will be marked as reserved.

Where is the building's entrance?

The main front entrance is located off Commonwealth Ave on the north side of the building, located between "The Bowery" and "Stubrik's Steakhouse". Enter through the glass door and up the staircase which will lead you directly to the lobby and box office.

Is there free parking?

Yes, the ground level parking is often full on Friday nights (except for handicap spaces) due to the many restaurants and bars nearby. For that reason, we recommend the free parking in the multi-level structure on E Santa Fe Ave & S Pomona Ave (5-minute walk to the ballroom).

When should I arrive?

Doors open at 6:30pm. Refreshments will be available for purchase in the lobby and some musicians from the band will be playing before the show starts at 7pm.

Will food and beverage be served?

Light refreshments and non-alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase in the front lobby before the show and during intermission.

Can I purchase tickets at the door?

Yes, unless the show is sold out. Cash, check, and card all accepted. Tickets are also available at www.jazzmagicshow.com

Is there elevator access?

While we ask guests to take the front north entrance if they can do so, if you require the use of an elevator, there is another entrance you may use located in the south side of the building. From the parking lot, approach "Bourbon Street" and go right until you reach the elevator. Then go to the second floor, left into the ballroom, and then forward to the front lobby for check in.

Where is the Atomic Ballroom Fullerton located?

The ballroom is located on the second floor of the Williams building near the corner of Commonwealth Ave and Harbor Blvd. It is directly above the restaurants “The Bowery” and “Bourbon Street” and shares parking with the Fullerton Train Depot.

Is there a senior/student discount?
